

STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

RETENTION RATE: Retention rates measure the percentage of first-time students who return to the institution to continue their studies the following fall or completed their studies within the reporting period. The Fall 2016 cohort retention rates reflect students enrolled between 8/1/2016 and 10/31/2016 who completed or were still enrolled between 8/1/2017 and 10/31/2017.

Only first-time, full-time certificate seeking students are included in the calculation.
